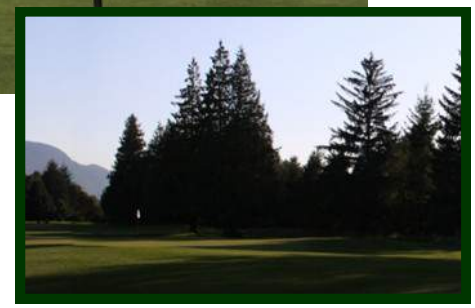
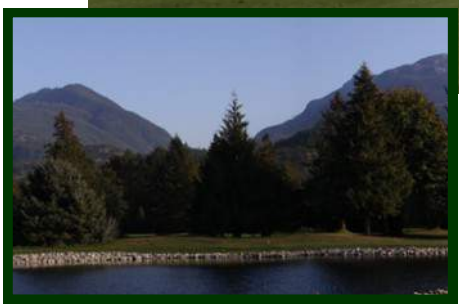

Vancouver area blessed with plethora of beautiful and highly playable public courses.

There are some fine courses in and around Whistler—pricey, but fine—but this old beauty at Squamish is the equal to any of them. Surrounded by mountains but laid out over a largely flat piece of land, the physical setting is stunning. The course itself isn't overly long but it's unrelenting in its demands. The back nine especially, requires a deft touch around the challenging greens. Local knowledge also come in handy. There isn't a signature hole per se but 10 through 13 represents a wonderful stretch. Squamish doesn't beat you up like longer courses but there is trouble on virtually every hole and sooner or later, it will find you. The challenge is more subtle but it's equally daunting. Walking off the 18th green, you always think, "I should have scored better than that". But you never do.

# Terms & Conditions

- 1. Deposits:** A Non-Refundable Deposit of 25% and the signed contract are required in order to confirm the booking. SVGC reserves the right to release all space for re-sale if the deposit and contract are not received on or before the date indicated.
- 2. Payment:** Credit card number and signature must be provided to ensure and authorize payment of any unpaid balance owing after the event. Cheques must be made payable to SVGC.
- 3. Cancellation:** Cancellations for group or tournament must be received in written form by fax or mail sixty (60) days prior to the date of the event. A confirmed acknowledgement of the cancellation must be noted from SVGC to ensure that cancellation charges are not applied. Phone cancellations are not final.
- 4. Tee Time Group/Golf Events:** SVGC will allow the following attrition schedule for Tee Time Group / Tournament Events: (not applicable to Shotgun Tournament Events)
  - A) 59-30 days before the date of play – no charge for reduction up to 50%**
  - B) 29-15 days before the date of play – no charge for reduction up to 20%**
  - C) 14-10 days before the date of play – no charge for reduction up to 10%**
  - D) Any reductions to the group's Tee Times that exceed the above allowed percentages will be held against the advanced deposit. Resold Tee times will be rebated against the attrition charge. group rate will not apply if group drops below 24 players.**
  - E) Increase:** subject to availability needs to be made at least 10 days prior to event.
- 5. Shotgun Golf Events:**
  - A)** Shotgun bookings are based on a field of 100 players. Golf Event Hosts electing to do a Shotgun Event will be required to pay the full Shotgun Golf Event Package price, unless otherwise added to the final contract.
  - B)** A reduction in numbers below 100 players for Shotgun Events may affect Club's decision to allow a Shotgun format. Format must be confirmed with our Pro Shop staff in this case.
- 6.** The remaining balance must be paid upon arrival unless pre-approved to be paid upon invoice.
- 7. Alcohol:** The Course is a Licensed Premise and no outside alcohol is permitted.
- 8. Sponsorship Guidelines:** All on-course sponsorship must be approved by the General Manager.
- 9. Responsibility:** The patron assumes responsibility for the undue damage to the premises/property. The Club does not assume responsibility of any merchandise or articles left at the Club before, during or after the function. This includes sponsorship signage and banners, equipment, supplies and other such items of this nature.
- 10. Golf Event Host:** The Golf Event Host is responsible for the repair and /or replacement of power carts and rental clubs in the event that these items are damaged, lost or stolen.
- 11. Dress Code:** On-Course/Driving Range: no cut offs allowed. Men: collared shirts required. Ladies: sleeveless tops require a collar, tops with sleeves do not require a collar.
- 12. Pace of Play:** Squamish Valley Golf Club aims for a 4 hour and 15 minute round of golf at all times, excluding shotgun rounds. Our course Players Assistants have full authority to maintain this pre-determined pace of play expectations. Groups failing to meet these expectations, the day of, may be asked to pick up their ball and advance to the next hole.



## Tournament Planner & Checklist

### **Planning a Successful Event**

It is our pleasure to provide you with the following information to help you plan your tournament event. We are happy to work closely with you to ensure that every detail is looked after. Please feel free to contact us with any questions you may have.

### **30-60 Days Prior to your Event**

- Confirmation of Format – Texas Scramble, etc.
- Confirmation of Contests – (LD) Longest Drive, (KP) Closest to the Pin, Hole-in-One
- Confirm prizes and scoring
- Confirm registration set-up requirements
- Discuss menu selections
- Discuss bar requirements
- Discuss restaurant set-up: # of people, prize tables and equipment
- Table and chair requirements
- Forward Tournament Agreement with deposit

### **15-30 Days Before Event**

- Confirm all course requirements and details: i.e. meals, ice, etc.
- Forward event information to all participants
- Confirm registration time
- Confirm on-site/restaurant & meal times
- Provide participants with driving directions to the course
- Dress code in effect – soft spikes only

### **15 Days Before Event**

- Confirmation of final number of participants
- Forward balance of payment

### **7 Days Before Event**

- Forward tournament groupings (draw sheet)
- Confirm number of rental club sets
- Finalize on-site/restaurant menu selections

### **2 Days Before Event**

- Deliver all event signage and on course materials
- Fax or Email Draw

### **Event Day**
