



## **SVGC COVID-19 Response**

In order to provide our Members, Guests, Staff, and any other visitors to the Club the safest possible environment in which to enjoy a round of golf and our Restaurant services, we have put in place safety plans relating to all activities on our premises. Our protocols and procedures have been formulated based on the direction from both Federal and Provincial Health Authorities and they are frequently revised to take into account any new orders or mandates.

### **Golf Procedures and Expectations**

- If you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with anyone that has tested positive for Covid-19 or is awaiting results from a Covid-19 test, we ask you not visit our facility. This also applies if you have travelled outside of Canada in the previous 14 days. If in doubt, a self-assessment tool is available at the following link <https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en>
- 'Social Distancing' must be adhered to whilst on the premises. 6 feet distancing is the minimum. During your round and while on Club premises remember that this means no high-five's, shaking hands etc.
- To attend the course, you must have a tee time booked. We will not accept 'walk-ons at this time.
- Only members, passholders and those that have paid a green fee are permitted on the course. We cannot permit spectators or 'ride-alongs'.
- Players are not to arrive at the course more than 25 minutes prior to their booked tee time (unless making use of the restaurant)
- When checking in at the Proshop, only two customers are permitted in the shop at a time and a mask must be worn at all times.
- We have removed all rakes, ball washers and drink stations from the course. Flagsticks are to remain in place. Cup depth has been elevated to allow for easier retrieval of the ball without the need to remove the flag.
- A maximum of 4 players at a time are allowed on our practice putting and chipping greens.
- Our rental Power Carts and Push Carts are sanitized thoroughly before each use.
- Under the current PHO orders in place, SVGC may only allow sharing of golf carts with those living in the same household. Riding with a golfer who does not live with you is not permitted.

- It is requested and would be greatly appreciated if golfers remove their own garbage and recycling from carts after use.
- We have washroom facilities available at the Clubhouse, the 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> tee as well as the 10<sup>th</sup> tee. When using the washrooms please ensure to sanitize your hands with the Club provided sanitizing spray prior to entering the washrooms.
- After your round we ask all members and daily green fee players to return to their vehicles and depart the premises unless making use of the Restaurant. Please, no loitering/tailgating in the parking lot.

### **Restaurant and Clubhouse Operations**

We are guided by the Provincial and Local Area Health Authorities in respect to indoor and F&B operations. Procedures, rules, and protocols change frequently. With the current orders in place the following rules must be adhered to;

- If you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with anyone that has tested positive for Covid-19 or is awaiting results from a Covid-19 test please do not visit our Restaurant. This also applies if you have travelled outside of the country in the past 14 days. If in doubt, a self-assessment tool is available at the following link <https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en>
- Guests must provide their name and contact details in order to be seated at a table. This is to aid in Contact Tracing efforts if a Covid-19 positive customer were to visit the facility.
- All guests of the restaurant must wear a mask until seated.
- A maximum of 6 people are permitted to be seated at one table.
- Restaurant guests must be seated a minimum of 2 meters from guests at another table.
- Guests must remain at their table and may not move amongst customers at other tables.
- Guests are asked to adhere to the requests of staff and signage re entry and exit of the building.

### **Squamish Valley Squash Club**

With the current PHO orders in place Squash at SVGC is played only under the following conditions;

- If you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with anyone that has tested positive for Covid-19 or is awaiting results from a Covid-19 test please do not visit the Club. This also applies if you have travelled outside of the country in the past 14 days. If in doubt, a self-assessment tool is available at the following link <https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en>
- Members and 5-Visit Passholders only, no drop ins are permitted.
- Solo play only unless playing with someone residing in the same household.
- Online court bookings must be made. No drop-ins.
- Locker rooms, showers and saunas are closed and not to be accessed.

- Upon reaching the end of your booked time, please remove all your belongings and vacate the premises. No socializing with other squash players after play.

SVGC takes the threat and risk of COVID-19 very seriously and in addition to the above protocols and procedures we also ensure;

- Frequent cleaning and sanitization of high contact touch surfaces
- Daily staff health confirmations
- Masks worn by staff at all times when indoors.
- Plexiglass barriers at POS terminals.
- Frequent cleaning of washrooms.
- Adherence to all orders and mandates put in place by the Provincial Health Officer.
