Beverage Cart Attendant/s (Seasonal) - Squamish Valley Golf Club

JOB SUMMARY

- Provides a high level of customer service to golf members and guest.
- Travels the course in the Beverage Cart to sell drinks and snacks to golfers
- Maintains the stock and cleanliness of beverage cart
- May also be required to work in the 10th Tee Cabin providing similar service.
- Reports to F&B Manager

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

The essential job functions include, but are not limited to the following:

- Checks with Proshop Staff on daily play schedule.
- Operate beverage cart in a safe and responsible manner.
- Serves alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks for golfers out on the course.
- Follows policy's and checks golfers identification when selling alcohol.
- Maintains the inventory and sales of the cart and records in POS system.
- Maintains the stock on the cart - loading and unloading.
- Ensures the cleanliness of the cart and removes trash.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

- Must have the ability to deliver a high level of customer service.
- Good oral communication skills.
- Must be able to safely operate the beverage cart.
- Can compute simple math and count change accurately.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

- Must be minimum 19 years old (alcohol service)
- Previous experience in food and beverage and guest services
- Must have Serving it Right certification
- Food Safe Level 1 certification will be looked upon favourably
- Flexibility with work availability is preferred
- Able to lift up to 10 kgs.
- Must have a valid driver's license
